

Golden Town Hall

Fall Yard Waste Round-Up

The Town of Golden will run its free Yard Waste Roundup on Thursday, October 20.

Residents can place yard waste in containers, compostable bags or bundles at their regular curbside collection area before 8 am for free pickup.

No registration is required.



Biosolid management

What's that smell?

Starting October 3, contractors will be hauling biosolids from the sewage treatment plant as part of the Town's Biosolid Management Plan.

Biosolids are the nutrient-rich organic materials resulting from the sewage treatment process. The Town's biosolids will be transported by truck for beneficial reuse on farmland



Your vote, your Golden!

This October, residents of Golden will vote to elect one mayor and six councillors to Town Council and vote on one referendum question posed by the Columbia Shuswap Regional District on borrowing funds to construct an indoor aquatic centre.

Advance voting

 Wednesday, October 5, from 8 am to 8 pm at Bagged yard waste MUST be in compostable bags or it will not be picked up.

This service is for yard waste only. This includes grass clippings, leaves, tree cones, tree branches, shrubs and bushes. These items must not exceed eight inches in diameter or eight feet in length.

Please bundle prunings to make it easier and faster for us to collect. No other types of waste will be accepted, including construction wood waste. south of Golden for hayfield production.

Trucks will be hauling biosolids from the Town's sewage treatment plant, located near the airport, for an estimated six weeks.

Residents along the truck route (Fisher Road, 5th Avenue South, 9th Street South and 10th Avenue S/Highway 95) may experience temporary odours during this time.
